## **eBankSystems Announces Release of Trinisys 9.1**

*Lubbock-based Banking Software Firm is Compliant with IAT Transactions  
Three Months before NACHA Deadline*

**LUBBOCK, TX June 29, 2009...** eBankSystems, Inc., a leading provider of banking software applications and services for community banks, today announced it has released version 9.1 of Trinisys.

NACHA has responded to the mandates of the Office Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) and the Financial Action Task Force (FATF). Consequently, ACH formats and rules for cross-border payments have changed. Trinisys 9.1 will now report the additional information from IAT transactions (foreign or “cross border”) as required by NACHA.

“We want to ensure that our customers have the tools they need to be compliant with the new guidelines for handling IAT transactions to satisfy their examiners. The other additions to Trinisys were the result of listening to our customers and ensuring that they have the features and functionality they need to serve their customers,” said Reed Swenson, director of development for eBankSystems.

Other key highlights of version 9.1 include several customer-requested enhancements. For example, Trinisys now allows loans to be collateralized by various deposit accounts such as a CD, IRA or money market account. Trinisys will track the value of the loan and hold the funds from the deposit account automatically.

Another key enhancement is the addition of more robust SBA loan functionality and features. Trinisys will allow the banker to set parameters and gather the necessary statistics automatically as the SBA requires for loan guarantees.

A final key customer requested enhancement: to help combat identity theft, if a customer's address changes, version 9.1 will automatically send a change of address notification to the customer to ensure the request was legitimate, and will present a notification to bank employees each time they access that customer's account.
